The City Council supports the Buhl Rural Fire Protection District in their efforts Section 1: of fire and EMS service.

As the Coordinator, for the Twin Falls County Office of Emergency Management. I would like to support the grant application submitted by the Buhl Rural Fire Protection District.

Over the last 27 years, as the County EM. I have worked with the Buhl Rural Fire Protection District to support all areas of fire management with federal grant funding for the purchase of equipment.

The City of Buhl (population of 4100) contracts for services with the Buhl Rural Fire Protection District to oversee fire suppression services for 5000 citizens for a total of 9100 individuals.

The Fire District addresses fire protection for all of the citizens in the city and county area. This area has a low socioeconomic status, which includes a high population of those who are elderly, disabled, and chronically ill. The district relies upon funding to support communication, EMS, fire prevention, training and building inspections in both the City of Buhl and rural geographical areas.

At this time, the Buhl Rural Fire Protection District needs funding to build a new fire station which will address the following: certification of staff, housing of apparatus, training, exercises sleeping/kitchen quarters, handicap accessible bathrooms for public meeting areas that meet ADA compliance.

In closing, I would ask that you consider this request to enhance the ability for the Buhl Rural Fire Protection District to continue to address and maintain life safety.

<u>Situation:</u> Buhl Rural Fire Protection District is seeking a community projects funding grant from to acquire property and build a new fire station in Buhl, Idaho

<u>Background:</u> Buhl Fire Department and Buhl QRU have a long history providing fire protection and medical response to the community of Buhl Idaho, they have operated out of their station at 201 Broadway Ave North in Buhl and maintain several fire apparatuses, two QRU vehicles, and extrication equipment for heavy rescue and entrapped patients.

Additionally, Buhl Fire Protection District provides a 911 emergency QRU for medical and trauma patients in their region. Buhl QRU has been providing rapid response to residents and patrons when in experiencing a medical emergency. In 2023, Buhl QRU responded to nearly 1,000 EMS calls in their district.

Buhl Rural Fire Protection District also maintains fire protection for the rural community from their leased facility, formerly Buhl Fire Department and their own remote location nearly 10 miles west of the city.

Assessment: Recently, due to financial constraints, the City of Buhl has elected to contract fire services to the Buhl Rural Fire Protection District. With this change, the current Buhl Rural Fire Protection District is required to lease their current building from the City of Buhl, at a reported cost of \$30,000 per year. This is forcing the Buhl Rural Fire District to seek plans to build their own station. Currently the rural fire district only has a single station nearly 10 miles west of the city of Buhl, on U.S. Highway 30, and the leased space at their previous (now leased) Buhl Fire Department location.

This leased facility does not provide adequate space for apparatus, personnel, and training requirements. It does not provide adequate sleeping quarters for 24-hour coverage, nor does it provide male / female separation facilities for sleep, locker/dressing rooms, and shower facilities. It does not provide adequate separation of contaminated and clean areas of operation, which is a health risk to the fire personnel.

The current fire protection district also has vacant property available ½ mile west of the populus of the City of Buhl, and if they choose to build on that property would increase their response times to most commercial structures, and a large portion of the new growth of residential properties in their district.

Buhl Rural Fire Protection District is seeking to purchase property on the east side of the City of Buhl where access to commercial properties would be preferential, however, with the recent changes they do not have the funding to purchase and build such a structure.

<u>Recommendations:</u> As the Manager of Magic Valley Paramedics, I ask that you consider supporting Buhl Rural Fire Protection District in their quest to fund a new station through available grants. Supporting Buhl Rural Fire Protection District is in the best interest of citizens and commercial property owners in the case of fire and emergency responses, will save endless lives, loss to property owners, and reduce the costs of insurance premiums to the members of the community.

The Buhl Rural Fire Protection District of Buhl, Idaho, is applying for a Community Project Funding Grant for the ability to build a new fire station. The Buhl Highway District of Buhl, Idaho, would like to express its support and believes that a new fire station will significantly improve the Fire District's services.

According to the Census Bureau, in 2021, Buhl, ID has seen an increase of 1.57% in population, and Twin Falls County has a 3.4% increase. With continued growth, the Buhl Fire District facilities are inadequate for the needs of the community. The current facility is being leased from the City of Buhl, and its size is insufficient to increase personnel and to add or upgrade equipment. The facility is accessed off Highway 30, where there is a lot of traffic, and has safety concerns for egress and ingress.

In 2021, Buhl, Idaho's median household income of \$40,765, saw a one-year decline of 2.77%. With the current state of the economy, our citizens are financially unable to afford the costs this project requires.

Twin Falls County fully endorses Buhl Rural Fire Protection District's application for a community projects funding grant.

The Buhl Rural Fire Protection District serves an area of over 102 square miles and 10,000+ residents. The facility that they currently operate from belongs to the City of Buhl and the District pays rent for this location. A new larger station would allow the District to be more centrally located to allow for quicker response as well as providing a facility that is large enough to house all of the vehicles inside. Currently the District must winterize vehicles during cold months which delays operational readiness for certain call types. The current station also does not have enough space to support an Advanced Life Support unit. The Buhl District is the only community of this size in our area without an ALS unit.

The existing facility also does not have adequate space for 24-hour coverage with individual sleeping quarters for on duty firefighters, ALS crews, regional volunteer, and potential resident firefighters. The new station would contain space to better accommodate female employees and volunteers with private separate sleeping quarters as well as a professional work place.

The Twin Falls County Commissioners ask that you look favorably on the Buhl Rural Fire Protection District's grant application. With your help, we can ensure that this essential service continues to receive the necessary resources to save lives and keep our community safe.
