I am requesting funding for the City of Twin Falls Wastewater System Upgrades in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Twin Falls located at 203 Main Avenue East, Twin Falls, ID 83301. The funding will be used for upgrades to the City of Twin Falls municipal wastewater system to include design, bidding, and construction of approximately 1 mile of 48-inch sewer gravity main line including all appurtenances per city standards and specifications along with repairing all infrastructure needing adjustment or replaced by such construction to current standards. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because investment in this project ensures critical infrastructure needs are addressed efficiently and effectively. The expansion of the municipal wastewater system not only serves current industry, but also prepares the community for future growth. Federal support enables the City to leverage local matching funds, stretching every dollar further and accelerating project delivery. By directing federal funds to this effort, Congress is supporting job creation, economic development, and environmental protection in a way that benefits both the local community and the broader region. This is a strategic investment that aligns national resources with local priorities, demonstrating responsible stewardship of taxpayer dollars and ensuring a lasting, positive impact for the citizens and businesses of Idaho's 2nd District.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Title VI of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C.1381 et seq.
